



PUTTER PALS LADIES LEAGUE

May 8, 2018

Updates for 2018! A FUN two person scramble format, team match play. There will be two halves to the season with the winners of each half playing a final match to determine overall winners. Putter Pals league is *every Thursday*, other scheduled events may affect league and will be announced.

- **Scramble Format:** Both players tee off, the best shot is selected and both players play from that spot, continuing on until the ball is holed, play is from the Red Tees.
- A schedule of matches will be set in advance. Players in the match will coordinate a time to start. The first tee for the course rotation will be **blocked for Putter Pals League from 3:30 to 5:15 pm** and golfers may start anytime that is convenient for all players.
- The nine holes will be divided into three 3-Hole Matches. Points are earned for each 3-Hole result for a total of 3 points that may be won. Win = 1 Half = 1/2 Loss = 0
- **End of Half, Four-Person Scramble.** The last date of each half will feature a four person scramble. Teams will be drawn by the golf shop with an A-B-C-D player in each group. Special payout to winning team!
- **Finals** will be a shotgun start at 5:00 pm on September 13th with a party to follow. Division winners from each half will go head to head. All other players will have a special golf format event.

ENTRY

Sign-up deadline is May 3, 2018. We will have a question & answer meeting at 5:30pm on May 3rd with a spectacular putting contest after the meeting. First day for golf will be May 10th.

- League entry is \$70 for a 2 person team, \$90 for a 3 person team, paid out to winnings teams & for party.
- Entry fee for the sub-pool player is \$15.
- The nine-hole golf rate is \$23.
- Optional weekly "game" fees - \$2 for two closest to the pins (\$1 each par 3) pay in golf shop.

SUBSTITUTES

Individual players may sign up without a team and be part of the sub-pool. A sub may only play twice with the same team per half. Subs may be contacted in advance by a team or, they can show up for league and sub in if there are no-shows. There will also be weekly Sub-Teams, arranged by the golf shop, if a team cannot make their match. Prizes for substitutes will be determined by the winning team players.

HANDICAP/RULES OF GOLF

Each golfer will be given a "Scramble Index" based on their average 9-Hole score. All USGA Rules apply except were modified by local rules (*sheet*), other local rules will be communicated based on course rotation used.

- Maximum team score per hole is 3 over par. Teams' may "pick-up" at any time if they are out of the hole.
- Handicap formula for team scramble: "A" Player = 35%, "B" Player = 15%
Matches with 2 Players vs. 1 Player: The 1 Player team will receive 50% of their "Scramble Index" and play 1 ball only.

- Formula for individual "Scramble Index" based on average nine hole score:

36 to 38 - 0	50 to 52 - 7	64 to 66 - 13
39 to 41 - 2	53 to 55 - 8	67 to 69 - 14
42 to 43 - 3	56 to 58 - 9	70 to 72 - 15
44 to 46 - 4	59 to 60 - 10	74 to 76 - 17
47 to 49 - 5	61 to 63 - 12	77 plus - 18

TIES

If there is a tie for "Half" winners, their head to head match results will determine who wins tie. If they tie their head to head or did not play each other, there will a sudden death playoff after each half ending date. If the second half winner is the same as the first half, the second place team of the second half will play to determine the overall winner in each division.
