



# MONDAY NIGHT MEN'S LEAGUE



**UPDATED MAY 7, 2020**

**Will start with a one MAY match, teams contact each other and arrange a time to play, anytime in May. Starting time is mandatory, call the golf shop to schedule. One rider per cart subject to availability, carts cannot be reserved for any reason. Other updates highlighted in yellow.**

The 2020 Monday Men's league is open to the public and White Hawk Country Club Members. Four-Ball Match Play Format: Play is from the white tees, super seniors age 65 and over will have the option to play from the gold tees. In four-ball match play, a two person team will match their better ball against the better ball of their opposing team.

- A team will have a **match** with a scheduled team (American Team 1 vs. American Team 6). Teams may be comprised of two or more players, however, only two players will compete each week. You may add an additional person to your team up to June 1. There are no subs.
- **Two divisions** will be created based on team total handicap. National League for low handicap teams, and American League for high handicap teams. All matches will be within your own division.
- **Points** will be earned with the result of each match: Win = 2 Loss = 0 Tie = 1 Participation = 1 So a winning team would earn 3 points, a losing team would earn 1 point, a tied match would earn 2 points each team. The last **2 weeks** of the season will be **double points, no halves**, payout for overall season.
- If hole is tied, **the second ball will be used as a tiebreaker for the hole**. If the team has only one player, there will be **no tiebreaker**. For a no-show team match, the team/player will have **a match against PAR**, the no-show team will receive 0 points.
- **Gift cards for golf shop merchandise** will be awarded to top teams in each division based **on final point standings**.

## STARTING TIME/SCHEDULE

League will start with one match in May, arranged by the golfers. In June, we will hope to have matches start under normal conditions. All matches should be completed by 7:30 pm. If a group/player is late and the golfers are off the tee, he/they may join the match on the next tee. If a date is missed due to weather/other, that week will be passed. **No Playoff Finals**, payout will be based on final standings will be a shotgun start at 5:00 pm on August 31<sup>st</sup> with the **dinner party** to follow.

## HANDICAPS/RULES OF GOLF

**Updates for 2020!** All USGA Rules apply, except were modified by local rules (sheet). The low handicap player in the match will play as scratch, all other players will receive the difference in handicap. **All players will be added to the Indiana Golf Association handicap service** and a USGA approved handicap will be maintained by the golfer/golf shop. Guidelines for handicap maintenance will be issued to all players. An average 9-Hole score, or a current USGA Index, must be given on entry form if you have not played in league before. Gold tee handicaps will be calculated for Super Seniors who have signed up to play from those tees for the season. Maximum 9-Hole league handicap is 15. Previous season scores will be used for those golfers without a USGA approved handicap in order to get one established. Handicap indexes on the **Saturday** prior to league date will be used.

## LEAGUE FEES

**Sign up and pay online** at [whitehawkcountryclub.com](http://whitehawkcountryclub.com) – **ONLINE STORE**. Two person team is \$90 each, a three person team is \$70 each. This fee will include the IGA Handicap Service, prize payout, and the season ending dinner party. Golfers may opt-in the weekly net skins game, \$5 cash per man paid in the golf shop, based off of full handicap, payout is in cash.
